

FINES AND COSTS POLICY FOR WAYNESBORO CIRCUIT COURT

Fines, costs and restitution due by a defendant as a result of a conviction/facts sufficient finding of this Court, are due within 30 days of sentencing/hearing. If they cannot be paid in that amount of time, courts costs and restitution ordered to be paid through the Clerk's Office could be subject to any one or all of the following; interest accruals at the legal rate, 17 % collection fees, suspension of their driver's license, employer garnishments, and interception of state tax returns.


Defendants may request additional time to pay their court costs/fines/restitution. However, the approval to do so will be under the full discretion of the Clerk of Circuit Court to determine the down payment required, the monthly installment due, and the date it is to be paid in full, unless otherwise previously ordered by the Court.
