

FLUVANNA COMBINED DISTRICT COURT'S POLICY CONCERNING PAYMENT OF FINES AND COSTS

Upon conviction for a criminal or traffic offense, the court will provide the defendant with a time to pay the fines and costs that considers certain elements, including, without limitation, the amount of the fine and costs, the defendant's ability to pay and financial circumstances, and participation in the fine option program. The court will review the elements referenced above with the defendant before setting a date.

The court will consider motions to extend the time to pay if the defendant files a motion with the court for an extension before the date the original fines and costs are due. The court will hear motions to extend the original time to pay on Tuesdays at 9:00 a.m. for General District Court and Wednesdays at 9:00 am for Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court
