


VIRGINIA:
AMHERST, BEDFORD, CAMPBELL, LYNCHBURG AND NELSON
GENERAL DISTRICT COURTS

1. If your fines and costs are not paid in full or a deferred payment plan is entered into within thirty (30) days of the date of your conviction, your account will accrue interest and/or a collection fee.
2. A payment plan that extends beyond 90 days from the date of conviction will incur an additional fee of \$10.00.
3. If the total fines and costs are \$500.00 or less, you may enter a deferred payment plan for up to 6 months. A down payment of 10% will be required to enter the plan. If fines and costs total more than \$500 the down payment is \$50 or 5% whichever is greater, with full payment to be made within 12 months.
4. No extensions can be granted by the Clerk's office.
5. You may petition the Court for modification of your payment plan. A modification may be granted by the judge if good cause is shown.
6. If you default on your payment plan you will incur additional collection fees and interest.
