

DANVILLE JUVENILE AND DOMESTIC RELATIONS DISTRICT COURT

Policy Regarding Use of Electronic Devices in Courtroom

Electronic devices containing information or evidence may be permitted in the courtroom subject to the following condition:

- 1) Upon entering the Courthouse the party desiring to utilize such a device shall display and present the device to and inform the Deputy at the metal detector that it contains information/evidence that is needed in court. The Deputy will then take measures to secure the device and make it available at the hearing(s) as needed.**
- 2) Failure to strictly follow the above-stated procedure will result in the denial of any request to use electronic devices in the courtroom. Please note: after hearings have commenced the court will generally not be in a position to wait for litigants or witnesses to retrieve devices from his/her vehicle or other places where they may be stored.**
