**TIME TO PAY AGREEMENT
EFFECTIVE 09/21/17**

When a defendant appears at the clerk's office window on the day of court to make arrangements to pay fines/cost they have 90 days to pay without the assessment of the \$10.00 time to pay fee.

If the defendant needs more time beyond the 90 days, the clerk may give them up to **6 months** to pay their fines and cost. A \$10.00 time to pay fee is added to total.

When a defendant request additional time to pay beyond the initial **6 months** that was given or their account is delinquent they must pay 10% down when the amount owed is \$500 or **less**. If the amount owed is **more** than \$500 then the amount due is 5% or \$50 whichever is greater.

If the defendant is unable to comply with the above then a financial statement DC-333 needs to be completed and the clerk will review it to determine if other arrangements can be made.

TIME TO PAY AGREEMENT EFFECTIVE 09/21/17

When a defendant appears at the clerk's office window on the day of court to make arrangements to pay fines/cost they have 90 days to pay without the assessment of the \$10.00 time to pay fee.

If the defendant needs more time beyond the 90 days, the clerk may give them up to **6 months** to pay their fines and cost. A \$10.00 time to pay fee is added to total.

When a defendant request additional time to pay beyond the initial **6 months** that was given or their account is delinquent they must pay 10% down when the amount owed is \$500 or **less**. If the amount owed is **more** than \$500 then the amount due is 5% or \$50 whichever is greater.

If the defendant is unable to comply with the above then a financial statement DC-333 needs to be completed and the clerk will review it to determine if other arrangements can be made.
