## **Granted Appeal Summary**

### **Assignments of Error**

1. The Court of Appeals erred in affirming the trial court, which erred in allowing the introduction of evidence of child pornography found on a computer in Appellant's bedroom because (a) such evidence was not relevant, (b) even if relevant, its probative value was substantially outweighed by the danger of unfair prejudice or its likelihood of confusing or misleading the jury, and (c) any legitimate probative value did not outweigh its incidental prejudice.

4. The Court of Appeals erred in affirming the trial court, which erred in denying Appellant's motion to have the jury individually polled for the jury's verdict because, contrary to the trial court's ruling, the motion was not untimely under Rule 3a:17 and because the jury had not yet started its deliberations on punishment.
