NOTICE: PERTAINING TO COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)-UPDATE

Due to the COVID-19 outbreak, the Supreme Court of Virginia issued a Third Order Extending Declaration of Judicial Emergency on April 22, 2020. In accordance with the aforementioned order and the Amended Extended Order entered by the Newport News Circuit Court on April 23, 2020, the Newport News Circuit Court Clerk's Office will continue to limit walk-in access through May 17, 2020. A reduced staff will continue to be in the office from 8:00 a.m.- 4:30 p.m., Monday-Friday.

Locked drop-boxes are available for the drop-offs of filings and recordings in the Circuit Courthouse lobby outside of the Circuit Court Clerk's office doors. Attorneys are requested to file all new civil matters using E-file.



AMENDED EXTENDED ORDER


UPON the Order Declaring a Judicial Emergency in Response to COVID-19 Emergency issued on March 16, 2020, by the Supreme Court of Virginia; the Order Extending Declaration of Judicial Emergency in Response to COVID-19 Emergency issued on March 27, 2020; the Third Order Extending Declaration of Judicial Emergency in Response to COVID-19 issued on April 22, 2020; and upon it appearing to the Court that the current COVID-19 outbreak continues to present a threat to the health and safety of the Clerk's Office personnel and the general public, and in an effort to prevent the spread of the virus while at the same time preserving mission critical and essential functions of the Clerk's Office as stressed by the aforementioned Supreme Court Orders; it is hereby

ORDERED that pursuant to §17.1-207 (A)(3), of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, the Clerk shall be permitted to limit walk-in access to her office, and shall continue to meet mission critical and essential functions as required by statute and the aforementioned Supreme Court Orders. This ability to limit access to her office and restrict functions shall be effective forthwith and shall continue through May 17, 2020.

This Order may be extended or rescinded as deemed necessary by the Court.


