AMENDED ORDER RE: COVID-19 NO. 3

This Court's Amended Order Re: Covid-19 No. 2 is hereby amended as follows:

The Court takes cognizance of (a) the Order Extending Declaration of Judicial Emergency in Response to Covid-19 Emergency entered by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Virginia on April 22, 2020 (the Amended Chief Justice Order) and (b) that certain declaration extending state of emergency through June 10, 2020, issued by the Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, and

It appearing to the Court that under the Second Amended Chief Justice Order all civil matters from April 27 through May 15, 2020 must be continued subject to the terms of that Order, and the Court having previously continued all civil cases on its docket through April 24, 2020,

It is ORDERED that all cases pending on the Court's 10:00 a.m. general docket during the period April 27 through May 15, 2020 be, and the same are hereby, CONTINUED to 10:00 a.m. on the date 10 weeks from the currently scheduled court date.

And it is FURTHER ORDERED that all motions and trials scheduled on the Court's docket from April 27 through May 15 be, and the same are hereby, CONTINUED. The parties are directed to contact the Clerk's Office to reschedule all such matters.

And it is FURTHER ORDERED that garnishment returns on the Court's garnishment docket during the period April 27 through May 15 may be continued on motion of the judgment debtor, but are otherwise subject to disposition on the return date.

And it is FURTHER ORDERED that during the period April 27 to May 15, 2020, the Court will continue to conduct hearings on emergency motions, including **but not limited to** motions to quash writ of eviction, for unlawful exclusion or seeking exemption(s) from garnishment.

This Order shall remain in effect pending further Order of the Court.
