


VIRGINIA: IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BEDFORD COUNTY

IN RE: Temporary Reduction of Operational Hours of the Circuit Court Clerk's Office

Upon consideration of the prevailing COVID-19 emergency, and the orders entered by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Virginia on March 16, 2020, March 27, 2020, April 22, 2020 and May 6, 2020, it is ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED in accordance with Section 17.1-207(A)(3) of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, that the order entered by this Court on March 17, 2020 is extended and that through June 5, 2020, the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Bedford County will be open during the hours of 8:30am until 1:00pm, Monday through Friday. During these reduced operational hours, wills may be offered for probate by appointment only. The Clerk's Office will resume normal operational hours on June 8, 2020, unless further order is entered.

This order shall have the same force and effect as a legal holiday pursuant to Sec. 1-210(B) of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended.
