The Amendment to the Fifth Order issued on June 8, 2020, is further modified as follows:

Recognizing that unlawful detainer actions and writs of eviction may issue for matters

unrelated to failure to pay rent, effective immediately, courts may hear residential unlawful

detainer actions, and issue writs of eviction, unrelated to the failure to pay rent for the remaining

duration of the Fifth Order (June 28, 2020).

All of the Justices agree.

It is so ORDERED.
