Alice Kay Perreault appeals the decision by the circuit court affirming a decision by the Virginia Employment Commission (commission) that disqualified her for unemployment compensation due to misconduct and holding that she had a fair and impartial hearing. We have reviewed the record, the circuit court's order, and the commission's opinion and find that this appeal is without merit. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the commission in its final opinion, see Perreault v. City of Norfolk, Comm'n Decision 87873-C (Nov. 5, 2009), as affirmed by the circuit court, see Perreault v. Virginia Emp't Comm'n, Case No. CL09-7082 (Apr. 24, 2009). We dispense with oral argument and summarily affirm because the facts and
