

PAYMENT AGREEMENT POLICY
GREENE GENERAL DISTRICT AND JUVENILE & DOMESTIC RELATIONS DISTRICT
COURT
Effective 7/1/2017

- Fines and costs are due the day of court. If you cannot pay the day of court you may sign a DC-210 (Acknowledgement of Suspension or Revocation of Driver's License) which will give you 30 days to pay. You will be required to give your correct mailing and street address, phone number and social security number to the court.
- If you cannot pay within 90 days you may request an extended payment agreement which will add a fee of \$10.00 to the amount you owe. If you have been making regular payments and need more time to finish paying, the court you may request an extension.
- You may request community service in lieu of monetary payment.
- If you have defaulted on a previous payment agreement the court will not grant another agreement unless a down payment of five percent of the total owed is made or \$50.00, whichever is greater.
- Restitution due dates are set by the judge as part of the case disposition. That date cannot be changed by a payment agreement.
- Guardian ad litem fees are civil fees. Non-payment will result in interest and collection fees but not in driver's license suspension.
- This policy is in accordance with Rule 1:24 of the Supreme Court of Virginia, posted in the lobby of the court office.
