Policy Requirements for Court Payment Agreements for the Collection of Fines and Costs

Time to Pay Policy

- If payment of a fine and/or costs cannot be made on the court day, you will receive ninety (90) days to make a full payment. After 90 days your account can be sent to collections and will have collection costs added.

- If you are unable to pay within 90 days, you may request and sign a written Time to Pay Agreement. A one-time fee of \$10.00 will be assessed in addition to the amount owed.

- If you are unable to pay in full by the date listed on your initial payment plan agreement, you may request additional time to pay your fines and costs in full.

- You may pay any amount you wish, at any time, during the deferred payment time.

- Interest will begin accruing on 181 days after your trial date with no payment agreement unless you are incarcerated, then it is 181 days following release date from incarceration.
