Assignments of Error

- 1. The Court of Appeals erred in affirming the trial court's denial of Appellant's motion to suppress his statement where the Appellant invoked his Fifth Amendment right to remain silent upon stating he had nothing more to say to a police detective, the police detective ended the interrogation, and another police detective from a different jurisdiction reinitiated the interrogation about a new offense approximately five minutes later.
- 2. The Court of Appeals erred in affirming the trial court's denial of Appellant's request for a mutual combat jury instruction where there was more than a scintilla of evidence of mutual combat, including an argument between Appellant and decedent that reasonably could have been viewed as an agreement to fight, people gathering to view the fight, people egging on both Appellant and decedent to fight, and an actual physical altercation.
