# **Assignments of Error**

- 1. The Court erred and abused its discretion in holding that conduct of Mr. Petersen violated Virginia Code § 8.01-271.1.
- 3. In the alternative, the Court erred and abused its discretion in the amount of sanctions awarded (\$54,056.15), because CNT NOVA, Inc. offered to mutually non-suit the case in December 2019, and the appellee unilaterally prolonged the litigation by refusing to enter the mutual non-suit until November 20, 2020, and incurred the substantial majority of its [sic] in connection with litigating their own counterclaim, which was non-suited, and upon which appellee ultimately did not prevail.
