Assignments of Error

1. The circuit court erred as a matter of law in granting a motion to strike Petitioners' evidence and in granting judgment to Respondents based upon the circuit court's mistaken construction of the language of Code of Virginia § 2.2-3701 defining the term "meeting."
2. The circuit court was plainly wrong or without support in the evidence to find that the attendance of the Respondents at the May 31, 2020, meeting at the Police Department was not a "meeting" within the meaning of that term in Code of Virginia § 2.2-3701.
