## **Assignments of Error**

- 1. The lower court erred in granting the Respondent's Motion to Dismiss Mr. Little's Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus without hearing oral argument, permitting any discovery, or taking evidence.
- 2. The lower court erred in finding that Mr. Little's false evidence claim is procedurally barred.
- 3. The lower court failed to consider Mr. Little's argument that any procedural default of the false evidence claim was excused by cause and prejudice.
- 4. The lower court erred in finding that the [sic] "an attorney's statement is not evidence" for purposes of Mr. Little's false evidence claim.
- 5. The lower court erred in holding that the Commonwealth did not knowingly present false evidence.
- 6. The lower court erred in applying the incorrect legal standard and holding that the Commonwealth's false evidence was not material.
