- i.  The age, physical and mental CONDITION OF THE CHILD or children, including extraordinary medical or dental expenses and child care expenses, Va. Code § 20-108.1 (B)(8)
- j.  The INDEPENDENT FINANCIAL RESOURCES, if any, of the CHILD or children, Va. Code § 20-108.1(B)(9)
- k.  The STANDARD OF LIVING for the family established during the marriage, Va. Code § 20-108.1(B)(10)
- l.  The earning capacity, obligations and needs, and financial RESOURCES OF EACH PARENT, Va. Code § 20-108.1(B)(11)
- m.  The EDUCATION AND TRAINING OF THE PARTIES and the ability and opportunity of the parties to secure such education and training, Va. Code § 20-108.1(B)(12)
- n.  The CONTRIBUTIONS, monetary and nonmonetary, of each party to the WELL-BEING OF THE FAMILY, Va. Code § 20-108.1 (B)(13)
- o.  The PROVISIONS made with regard to the MARITAL PROPERTY under Va. Code § 20-107.3, Va. Code § 20-108.1 (B)(14)
- p.  Tax consequences to the parties regarding claims for dependent children and child care expenses, Va. Code § 20-108.1 (B)(15)
- q.  Limited by PLEADINGS
- r.  A written agreement between the parties which includes the amount of child support, Va. Code § 20-108.1 (B)(16)
- s.  A *pendente lite* decree, which includes the amount of child support, agreed to by both parties or by counsel for the parties, Va. Code § 20-108.1 (B)(17)
- t.  Such OTHER FACTORS, including tax consequences to each party, as are necessary to consider the equities for the parents and children (Va. Code § 20-108.1 (B)(18) — describe briefly)
