The Uninsured Employer's Fund (hereinafter referred to as the Fund) appeals a decision of the Workers' Compensation Commission awarding David Scott Riggs (claimant) temporary total disability. The Fund contends the commission erred in finding the claimant demonstrated he was totally disabled from October 11, 2008 through March 29, 2009.

We have reviewed the record and the commission's opinion and find that this appeal is without merit. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the commission in its final opinion. See Riggs v. Boston's Essential Cuts Tree Service, VWC File No. VA010-0242-2200 (Mar. 2, 2010). We dispense with oral argument and summarily affirm because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before the Court and argument would not aid the decisional process. See Code § 17.1-403; Rule 5A:27.
