Blake Farm Dayschool, Inc. appeals a decision of the Workers' Compensation

Commission finding that Areti Stylianopoulos Thompson proved she sustained an injury by accident arising out of and in the course of her employment on April 6, 2005, and that her continuing symptoms and treatment were causally related to that accident. We have reviewed the record and the commission's opinion and find that this appeal is without merit. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the commission in its final opinion. See Thompson v. Blake
