McKinney Drilling Company, Inc., and its insurance carrier, Zurich American Insurance Company, appeal a decision of the Workers' Compensation Commission finding that Michele Peterson's ongoing right ankle and knee conditions were due to a 2005 compensable accident, that arthroscopic surgery to the right knee was reasonable and necessary, that she was entitled to a MRI of the right ankle, and that she was entitled to indemnity benefits from March 12, 2007 and continuing. We have reviewed the record and the commission's opinion and find that this appeal is without merit. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the commission in its final opinion. See Peterson v. McKinney Drilling, Inc./Keller Foundations, Inc., VWC File No. 224-52-62 (Oct. 24, 2008). We dispense with oral argument and summarily affirm because the
