

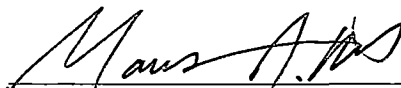
VIRGINIA: IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE COUNTY OF PATRICK

- I. Pursuant to Va Code §19.2-354.c the court establishes a program allowing any person upon whom a fine or costs have been imposed to discharge all or part of the fine or costs by earning credits for the performance of:
- (i) Community service work before or after imprisonment or
  - (ii) Work in accordance with provisions of the following:
    - A. Va Code §19.2-316.4 Eligibility for participation in community corrections alternative program; evaluation; sentencing; withdrawal or removal for program; payment of costs.
    - B. Article 3 (§53.1-41 et seq.) of Chapter 2 of Title 53.1-Employment and training of Prisoners
    - C. §53.1-128 Workforces and authorized work places
    - D. §53.1-129 Order permitting prisoners to work on state, county, city, town, certain private property or nonprofit organization property; bond of person in charge of prisoner
    - E. §53.1-131 Provision for release of prisoner from confinement for employment, educational or other rehabilitative programs; escape; penalty; disposition of earnings.

For the purposes of I. (ii), the credits may be earned while the person is imprisoned at a local, regional or state correctional facility

- II. Credits are to be earned at the rate of the Virginia minimum wage as provided in Va Code §40.1-28.10. For a person earning credits performing community service, the credit will be dollar for dollar applied to fines and/or costs. A person performing work while incarcerated will receive the same rate as the community service work rate less any wages received. The credits may be earned for any work done on or after July 1, 2023.
- III. The person requesting credits must submit verification of the hours worked. For community service work, the head of the organization or supervisor of the person having personal knowledge of the hours worked shall provide certification of the hours worked. Upon request of the person who has performed work while incarcerated or that person's designated representative, the local, regional or state correctional facility shall provide confirmation of the hours such person has worked and the credits earned for such work.
- IV. All persons requesting credits must submit an affidavit that the hours worked and amount of credits are only being submitted to this court, and not to any additional Virginia courts (no double dipping is permitted).
- V. Every person assessed fines or costs by this court shall be provided with written notice of the availability of earning credits, as well as the terms and conditions to discharge the fines and costs through performing community service or work performed while incarcerated.
