Assignments of Error

1. The Court of Appeals erred in ruling that the officer needed probable cause instead of reasonable suspicion to extend the traffic stop and to continue investigating and in finding that the trial court erred when it denied Henry's motion to suppress.
2. The Court of Appeals erred in ruling that the officer did not have probable cause to search Henry's vehicle; in failing to consider the totality of the circumstances that supported probable cause, including the evidence collected from Henry; and in concluding that the trial court erred when it denied his motion to suppress.
