**Assignments of Error**

- I. The Court of Appeals erred in reversing the circuit court's denial of Bullock's motion to strike because the evidence was not insufficient as a matter of law. A rational factfinder could find that Bullock's knife was a "weapon of like kind" to the enumerated weapons in Code § 18.2-308(A), and thus, the circuit court's judgment was not plainly wrong or without evidence to support it.
- II. The Court of Appeals erred by finding the trial record was devoid of evidence to establish Bullock's knife was "of like kind" to the enumerated weapons in Code § 18.2-308(A) because the knife was introduced into evidence for the fact finder to examine.
